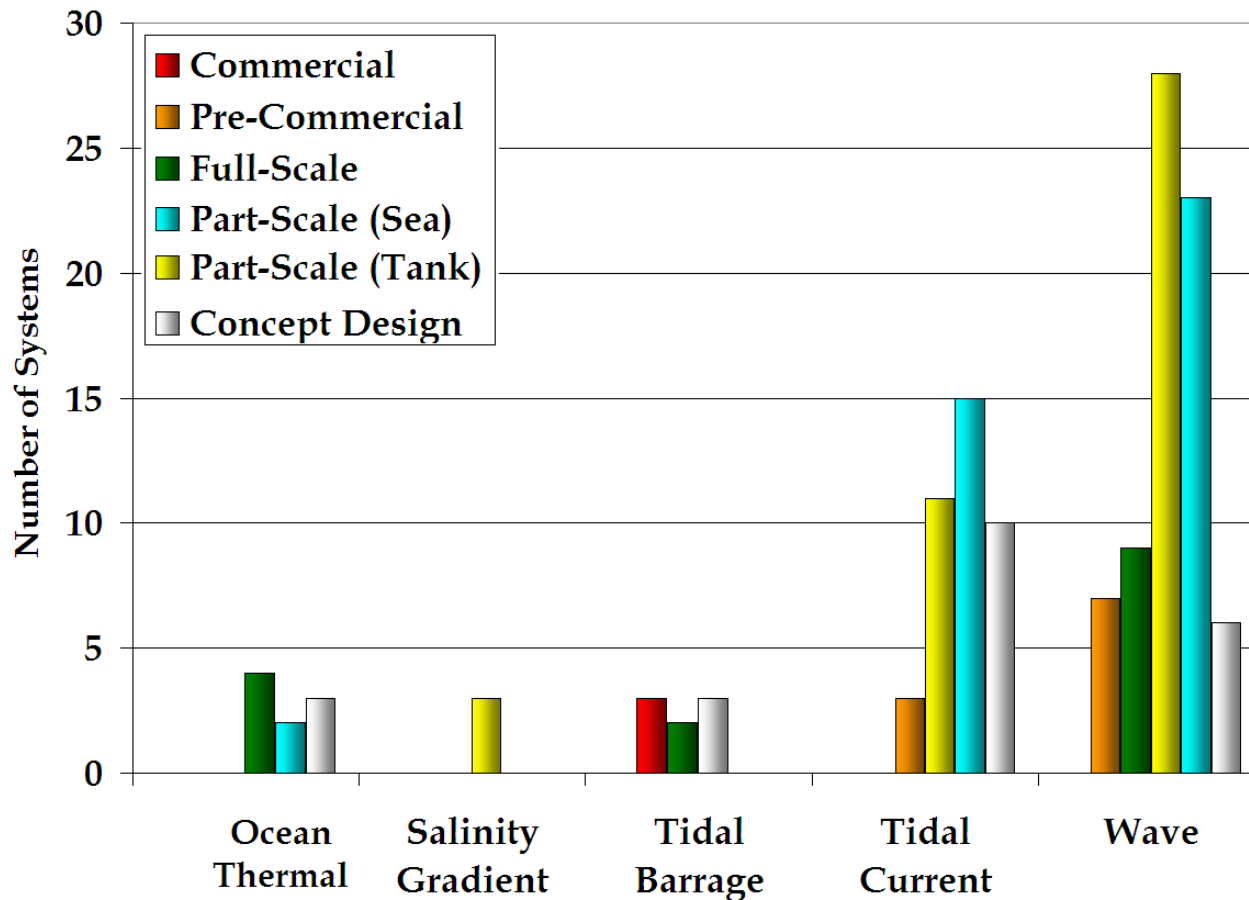

Types of Necessary Policies for an Emerging RE Sector

- **Research & Innovation Policy Supports**
 - National R&D Strategy, Govt. & private targeted R&D budget, Targeted RD&D programs with government depts./agencies, etc, R&D Networks
- **Market Deployment Policy Supports**
 - Target deployment, Obligations, Guaranteed prices/feed in tariff, Investment & production tax credit, Investment incentive, such as, capital grants, tradable certificates, Regulatory & administrative rules, public infrastructures
- **Market-based Energy Policy Supports**
 - Competitive market framework with internalization of externalities

- UK, Ireland, Portugal, France, Germany, Japan, New Zealand

□ Public Demonstration Infrastructure:
